Training Opportunities

MaineHealth offers a variety of paid training and learning opportunities as well as tuition reimbursement for eligible employees. In addition to the training opportunities listed below we partner locally and regionally with colleges, schools and other community-based programs.

Certified Nursing Assistant Programs

The Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) is a trained healthcare professional working on the patient care team. CNAs provide direct patient assistance with activities in daily living and basic needs. CNA training programs through MaineHealth provide an introduction to healthcare. No prior experience or higher education required. Completion of high school diploma or equivalent required. Upon successful program completion, students are guaranteed an interview for employment. Training programs are available regionally at: Maine Medical Center, LincolnHealth, Pen Bay Medical Center, Mid-Coast School of Technology.

Maine Medical Center School of Surgical Technology

The Surgical Technologist is a trained healthcare professional who provides direct support to the team delivering surgical care in the Operating Room (OR). They are responsible for activities that provide a safe and efficient environment for surgical care. Students enrolled in the one-year MMC School of Surgical Technology will learn about the basic sciences, patient care and safety, as well as principles of the (OR). No prior experience or higher education required. Completion of high school diploma or equivalent required. Upon successful school completion, students are guaranteed an interview for employment.

Medical Assistant Programs

The Medical Assistant is a trained healthcare professional who works directly with patients and supports both the physician team and the medical office team. Students in the program will learn medical assisting skills such as taking vital signs, blood pressure and pulse, in addition to clerical tasks such as updating patient medical records and filling out insurance forms. No prior experience or higher education required. Completion of high school diploma or equivalent required. Upon successful program completion, students are guaranteed an interview for employment. Training programs are available regionally at: Maine Medical Center/Maine Medical Partners and Southern Maine Health Care, Franklin Memorial Hospital.

NorDx Phlebotomy School

The Phlebotomist is a trained healthcare professional who explains blood-drawing procedures and draws blood from patients for prescribed medical tests. The NorDx Phlebotomy School 6-week program provides students with the clinical knowledge and skills necessary to become a certified phlebotomist, which include learning the anatomy of the circulatory system, clinical best practices, safety and ethical standards, and customer service. No prior experience or higher education required. Completion of high school diploma or equivalent required. Upon successful course completion, students are guaranteed employment.
