CAREER AWARENESS, SPEAKERS & EVENTS

Guest Speaker (1/2 hr - 1hr)

- The guest speaker connects classroom learning to the community by speaking on areas of expertise and personal career journeys. This model is intended for small groups with targeted interest or full classrooms.
- Offered virtually or in person depending on the date/time, region, and area of specialty requested.

Panel Presentations (1/2hr - 1hr)

- Panelists participate as industry experts alongside colleagues and other professionals. The goal is to provide a multi-perspective view on a specific topic to expand knowledge and increase awareness for students.
- Offered virtually or in person depending on the date/time, region, and area of specialty requested.

Informational Sessions & Career Exploration (1/2 hr - 2hrs)

- Informational interviews allow students to ask questions directly to practitioners in order to learn about their individual career pathway and gain insights about working within the healthcare industry.

- Offered virtually or in person depending on the date/time, region, and area of specialty requested
